Parade Theme: “Back the Blue”

Welcome to the 64th Annual Brush Rodeo and Parade!! The parade theme this year, “Back the Blue”, is in honor of our local law enforcement, sheriff’s dept and state patrol officers who put their lives on the line every day.

PLEASE NOTE: Due to the construction at the high school, the high school parking lot will be unavailable for our lineup this year. Parade participants will need to enter on Edmunds St off of Hospital Road. The parade will lineup along Edmunds St in 2 rows between Centre Ave and Hospital Road. Any overflow will line up one street to the north on Eaton St between Centre Ave and Hospital Road (see map).

If you are dropping off parade participants, you will need to **park on a side street and walk into the Parade Line Up area. Non-participant vehicles dropping off parade participants, WILL NOT be allowed in the Parade Line Up area. Please ensure all of your float participants are aware of this to avoid any congestion/confusion.**

Participants who need to park trailers: Trailer parking will be along Yellowstone Ave and the far west end of Edmunds St on the west side of Brush by Watrous Disc Golf Park (see map). Horses and their riders can use the Methodist Church parking lot, Registration (red on map) as a staging area (please be respectful of the church and clean up after your horses).

Shriners will line up along Eaton Street by Centre St to enter the parade.

The parade will start at the corner of Centre Ave and Edmunds St, then East to Cameron St, then north on Cameron St and continue on to Mill St where the parade will disburse. Judging will be done at Library Park.

We ask you to abide by the following rules: **Throwing candy or other items from moving vehicles or floats is strictly prohibited.** Individuals on foot may pass out candy or other items. Outriders or walkers are to be provided for all draft horse teams, mule or horse drawn floats or wagons. Two-wheel motor cross bikes or motorcycles are prohibited from doing “wheelies” during the parade.

Please return the attached entry form and, if you want to be judged, the \$15 fee, \$5 for non-profits, to the Brush Chamber office by 4pm on Monday, July 2nd to be eligible for judging. If you do not want to be judged, there is no entry fee. Plan to be present, registered and pick up your entry number in front of the Brush United Methodist Church, 1701 Edmunds St by 9:30am on the 4th. The parade will start at 10am.
