Parade Theme: “Celebrating 65 Years of Cowboys, Kids and Country”

Welcome to the 65th Annual Brush Rodeo and Parade!! The parade theme this year, “Celebrating 65 Years of Cowboys, Kids and Country”, which really says who we are and what we are all about.

PLEASE NOTE: Due to the construction at the high school, the high school parking lot will be unavailable for our lineup this year. Parade route will change some this year. Parade participants will need to enter on Mill Street then south on Ray Street. The parade will start lining up in the Thomson Elementary School parking lots and then continue north on Ray St up to Mill St (see map).

If you are dropping off parade participants, you will need to **park on a side street and walk into the Parade Line Up area. Non-participant vehicles dropping off parade participants, WILL NOT be allowed in the Parade Line Up area. Please ensure all of your float participants are aware of this to avoid any congestion/confusion.**

Participants who need to park trailers: Trailer parking will be in an empty lot north of the cemetery off of Mill St and north on Ray St (see map). Horses and their riders can ride down Ray St to Thomson Elementary School on the south side of the school (please be respectful and clean up after your horses).

Large tractors – will line up on Ray Street heading south (school parking lots are not big enough to maneuver through).

Shriners – enter on Mill Street (east or west), south on Lincoln Street, west on Everett St to New Hope Community Church parking lot. You will stage in the parking lot and grassy area.

The parade will start in the Thomson Elementary School parking lots onto Daniels St to Edmunds St, then East to Cameron St, then north on Cameron St and continue on to Mill St where the parade will disburse. Judging will be done at Library Park.

We ask you to abide by the following rules: **Throwing candy or other items from moving vehicles or floats is strictly prohibited.** Individuals on foot may pass out candy or other items walking along the curb area near the spectators. Outriders or walkers are to be provided for all draft horse teams, mule or horse drawn floats or wagons. Two-wheel motor cross bikes or motorcycles are prohibited from doing “wheelies” during the parade.

Please return the attached entry form and, if you want to be judged, the \$15 fee, \$5 for non-profits, to the Brush Chamber office by 4pm on Tuesday, July 2nd to be eligible for judging. If you do not want to be judged, there is no entry fee. Plan to be present, registered and pick up your entry number in front of Thomson Elementary School on Ray St (under the only tree) by 9:30am on the 4th. **Please park first and then pick up your number.** The parade will start at 10am.
